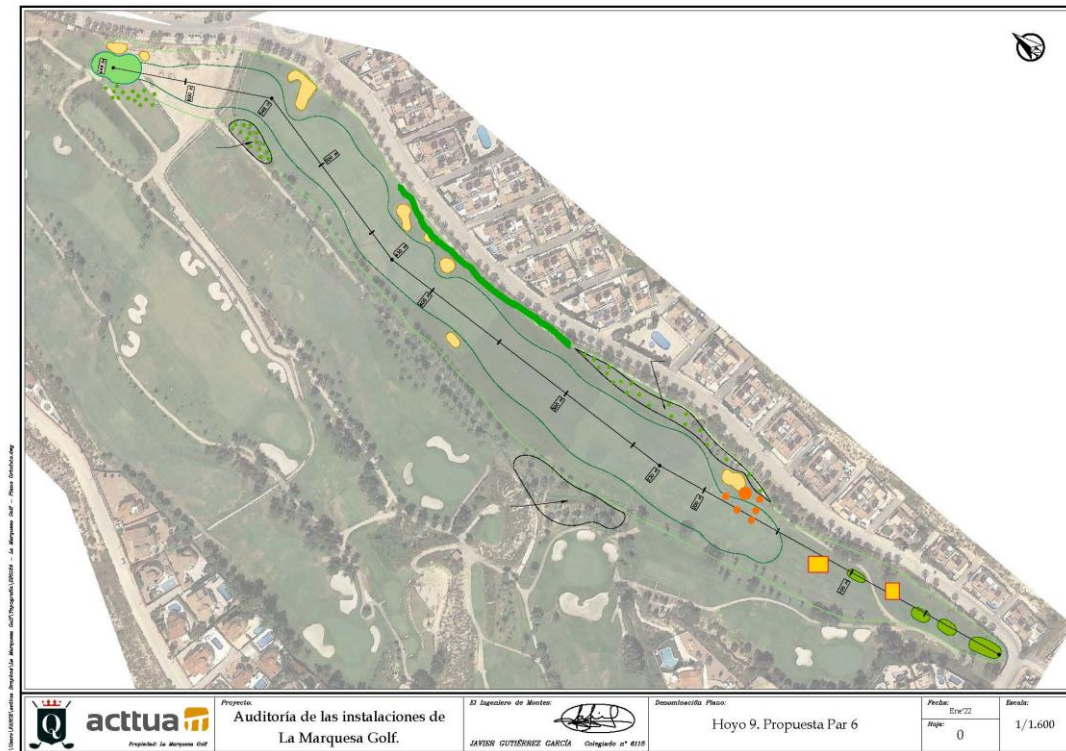


Opening of Spain's first par 6 and longest par 5 at La Marquesa Golf, Alicante



La Marquesa Golf, located in Rojales, Alicante, has made history by opening the first par-6 golf hole in Spain. This innovative hole is part of an ongoing effort to improve the playing experience and attract golfers of all levels, consolidating the club's position as a benchmark in the world of golf in the region.

The opening of this par-6 hole, which boasts an impressive 644 meters from the teeing ground, 623 meters from the yellow, 593 meters from the blue, and 505 meters from the red.

The idea of a par-6 hole is unconventional, as most golf courses include par-3, par-4, and par-5 holes. However, this innovative design allows golfers to enjoy a unique experience, allowing them to plan their shots with strategic attention, considering the different course options.

The hole, designed by Iñaki de La Cuadra, an architect who has worked with renowned designer Peter Harridane on more than 25 course designs around the world, has combined the existing par 5 with the construction of a new green complex, extending the end of the hole and changing its playing philosophy, which was previously almost straight, with a slight dog leg to

the left that affects the final shot.



Furthermore, this hole will also be playable as a par 5, thanks to the construction of teeing platforms that maintain the distances of the old hole. Players will be able to choose which platform to play from and whether they want to play the hole as a par 5 or par 6, offering various play options to suit different skill levels.

One consequence of the construction is that it has become the longest par 5 in Spain, at 628 meters, which will surely be a challenge for the most experienced players.

Club president José Ángel Quesada highlighted the importance of this new hole in Spanish golf. "The opening of this par 6 is a great step toward innovation and diversifying the challenges golfers face on our course. We want La Marquesa Golf to be a place where players can enjoy themselves, improve their game, and find new experiences while practicing their favorite sport. I believe this par 6, along with the exact copy of Sawgrass' 17th that we have on the second part of the course, makes La Marquesa Golf an attractive course that you will surely remember," he commented.

La Marquesa Golf has not only focused on creating an exciting hole, but also intends to promote tourism in Rojales and the Alicante region with this initiative. The arrival of golfers from all over the country and abroad will translate into an economic boost for the area.
